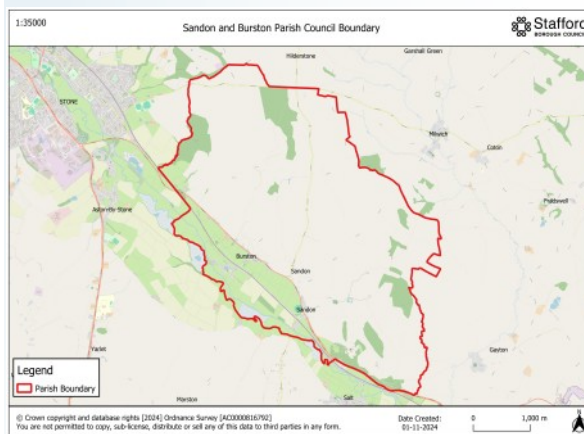

A parish council is the first tier of local government, and closest to the community.

We are a vital part of any community and the Council consists of 7 elected Councillors, who represent the community.

We meet bi-monthly and residents are welcome to come along. Meeting dates are on our website.



### How we can help:

- We can liaise with Higher Authorities on residents concerns.
- We can report pot holes.
- We can comment on Planning Applications.
- We can contribute to traffic calming projects.
- Provide Community Grants to local Groups.
